Upcycling: create storage by replacing cornflakes with magazines

You will need...

- One roll of d-c-fix[®] in Oak Sheffield Umbra
- One roll of d-c-fix[®] in Sonoma Oak Light
- One roll of d-c-fix[®] in Sanremo Oak Sand
- One d-c-fix[®] tool kit with smoother and cutter knife
- 3 empty cereal boxes
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Ruler



Step 1

Use the cutter knife to remove the top end of the box.

Step 2

Now, cut the front and the back sides of the box as well as one edge side diagonally downwards, and remove the cut cardboard.

Step 3

Now it's time to do some measuring. Measure the dimensions of all sides of the box, transfer those outlines to the backing paper of the adhesive film, then cut out the corresponding pieces of adhesive film.

Step 4

Next, pull back the backing paper of the film just a bit, and start affixing the film to the box, working with the smoother inch by inch around the box.
